Strike the ball out in front of your body.

Too many players hit the ball in line with their stepping in foot or slightly behind it. You should feel your racket head is reaching out to strike the ball slightly in front of your grip hand(s). Striking out in front of your body gives you more power and better placement.

Spring is here and we are ready to open our dining room!


