#### And critically:

- NO PRACTICE is permitted on course, EVER.
- Nothing is more disappointing and frankly unacceptable than finding three or four unrepaired divots in a row on our fairways. This must stop.
- Please report any concerns or instances you observe to the Golf Pro shop
- Please use the 18th green area for your practice needs, and as always George is glad to offer lessons there or on state of the art Trackman.
- 4) Please make dining reservations for parties of 6 or more, and we appreciate your patience and understanding during any busy periods.

5) As you all know, July and August tend to be the slowest months of the year at MFC. And with the reopening of the State and the Country, we expect that this summer will be similar to pre-pandemic summers. The MFC Team will monitor demand and may adjust our bar and dining hours and offerings. Any changes will be communicated via email and posted in the clubhouse and video display. Tennis and pickleball have never been busier with members and guests. While we are thrilled with all the activity, we ask that you please review our guest policy for tennis and pickleball and follow it. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation.

#### **TENNIS and PICKLEBALL GUEST POLICY**

1. Moorestown Field Club tennis and pickleball courts are available to members and their invited guests. Guests must be accompanied by their host members. **You must register your tennis guests on the message board outside the tennis pro's office** 

and your pickleball guests outside the pickleball court. The tennis pro will monitor the guest sheets.

2. Non-members may enjoy guest privileges a total of **three times** during any calendar year. Host members are responsible for registering their guests prior to play. The guest will enjoy the same privileges as members and will be expected to observe all club rules and etiquette. The host members are responsible for all actions of their guests.

3. Guest fees are currently \$15.00 per guest for tennis and \$15.00 per guest per day for pickleball. Guest fees will appear on monthly statements. Please contact the club office manager at 609/235-1464 with any questions or concerns.

MFC golf members are entitled to play tennis 5 times a year and are required to register in the guest book. They are allowed to bring guests a total of 3 times a year and must register their guests at the tennis pro's office.
