We are off to a good start in 2021 as many of our tennis members want to play almost regardless of the weather. Neither rain, snow, ice, wind or cold can deter a very determined bunch of MFC tennis players not to be on the outside courts. Squeegeeing is in high gear during rain, snow shovels in hands after snowfalls, and a lot of warm clothes have kept our courts playable this winter. We have done a few lessons at 25 degrees, 13 degree wind chill, and groups when temperatures are 28.

It not just that some people are out playing but three courts of players doing drills in this extreme weather. Most players love it and actually shed a bunch of clothes as they warm throughout the session. MFC tennis courts are well wind blocked so that helps a bunch. Don't be surprised in March if you drive by the courts and see players in shorts and short sleeves when temps are in the 40s because they will feel like it is summertime.

Currently we are using an underground watering system that is getting a bit old but still adequate. Baring any further COVID-19 outbreaks our three teams will compete beginning in late April against respective Cup teams throughout the Delaware Valley. 
