Thank you to everyone who participated in the annual Member Satisfaction survey. We had 239 responses, which equates to 53% of the memberships, up from 51% last year. The favorable results shown below reflect the collective efforts of your Board and our committees to improve your member satisfaction. This year's results and your specific comments will be used to identify and prioritize improvement opportunities for 2023 and the years ahead.

The detailed results will be posted to our website by the end of this month. But here are the percentages of respondents who are **Satisfied or Very Satisfied** with the key aspects of the club (question 3 on the survey):

- Overall: 95% - up 5% from last year
- Golf Course: 94% - up 7%
- Golf Shop: 96% - up 5%
- Club House: 84% - down 4%
- Tennis: 78% - down 6%
- Dining: 47% - up 10%
- Bar: 78% - no change
- Staff: 92% - no change

The significant increase in satisfaction with the Dining service is the direct result of actions taken to improve service and food variety. However, this remains the area in greatest need of improvement, and we continue to take actions. But for those of you who have not been here for lunch or dinner in a while, come experience the improvements made thus far. We understand that some members still prefer not to eat out, so we encourage you to enjoy the take-out service.

The Board will present the 2023 budget at the November Board meeting and approve it at the December meeting. Our key goals are to sustain the high level of member satisfaction, address high priority improvement opportunities, and fund required capital investments. We will balance these goals against the impacts of inflation and the uncertain economic headwinds in 2023.

A reminder that the Board recently approved changes to the payment provision for dues and any other financial obligations to the Club. These changes will go into effect with the November billing statements. Key changes are:

1. A \$25 late fee will be assessed for any past due amounts (not paid within 30 days of the billing date),
2. Accounts will be considered delinquent for any amounts not paid within 50 days of the billing date,
3. Any member sent two delinquency letters in a 12-month period will be required to provide a credit card, which the club will keep on file for payment of any future past due amounts.

The updated Membership Rules & Regulations will be posted this month.

Did you know that George Washington issued the first presidential proclamation of a Thanksgiving celebration in 1789. For decades, Thanksgiving was held on various dates until Abraham Lincoln proclaimed in 1863 that it should be celebrated the last Thursday of November.
