#### Bag and Cart Storage

There is limited room remaining in the bag room. Bag storage is \$110 for the year, cart storage is \$60 and \$150 for your cart and bag. Don't grip your racket too tight at the baseline!

When you are hitting forehands and backhands at the baseline, it's better to soften up your grip than to squeeze your grip too tight. This will allow your wrist to become involved in your stroke. You don't want too much wrist, but once you develop the feel, you will increase pace and spin.

#### Pickleball

MFC is set to convert the last tennis court into three permanent pickleball courts. Hopefully the transformation will begin soon, but we are at the mercy of the contractor. Our courts will look and play great with two tone colors and some temporary lights.
